GSL suspect was to see psychologist week of murder

Court hearings for Côte St. Luc murderer suspect Maor Attar will resume Nov. 1, after the prosecution lawyer studies a report that 18-year-old Maor Attar was not criminally responsible the day his 14-year-old sister Shirrel was murdered.

The same report, written by court-appointed expert Chantale Bouchard, says Attar is mentally fit to stand trial. Bouchard's report also says that on Aug.
